Established since 1996 it offers five years basic and clinical course of study leading to the degree of MBBS (Bachelor of Medicine & Surgery) and four years basic and clinical course of study leading to the degree of BDS (Bachelor of Dental Surgery). The college is affiliated with Riphah International University, Islamabad and is recognized by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM & DC) Islamabad. The college imparts medical knowledge and skills to the students of Islamic countries as well as to Pakistani expatriates, conducive to the principles and teachings of Islam, in order to mitigate the disease and poverty. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

MBBS Programme

- Applicant must have passed F. Sc (Premedical group) from Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Pakistan in first division securing 60% minimum aggregate (un-adjusted) marks.

OR

- B. Sc examination from a Pakistani University with Biological Sciences provided the candidate has passed the Intermediate Science Examination in Medical group securing 60% marks in aggregate un-adjusted, from Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education, Pakistan.
- Applicants who have passed examination of foreign university which in scope and standard is found equivalent to the Intermediate (Pre-medical) examination of Pakistan will be eligible for admission in medical College.
- The candidate must have passed the subjects of Biology, Physics, Chemistry and English in F. Sc (11th & 12th grade USA) examination. Only the subjects common to Pakistani Intermediate Boards will be considered for conversion purpose. The other subjects not taught in Pakistan (F.Sc. Pre-medical) will not be considered.
- An equivalence certificate from Inter-Board Chairmen Committee (IBCC), Islamabad will be provided by the applicant in case of foreign high school certificate.

- The equivalence certificate must be attached with the application form before the closing date. However, equivalence certificates of such applicants will not be accepted if they have not studied the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in 11th and 12th Grade.
- Any one beyond the age of 25 years shall not be admitted. Age limit is 17–25 years.
- The candidate should possess adequate mental and physical health to continue his/her course of studies.
- The Dean/Principal may cancel/refuse admission of/to any student without assigning any reason.

BDS Programme

- The candidate must have passed the Intermediate Science Examination with Pre-Medical Group of a Pakistani Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education securing at least 60% marks in aggregate un-adjusted.

OR

- The B.Sc. Examination from a Pakistani University with any group of subjects provided he/she has passed the Intermediate Science Examination Pre-Medical Group.

OR

- Any other Examination of a Foreign University, which in scope and standard is found equivalent to the Intermediate Science Examination (Pre-Medical Group) of a Pakistani Board.
- The admission will be made on merit.
- The candidate should possess adequate

mental and physical health to continue his/her course of studies.

- The Principal may cancel/refuse admission of/to any student without assigning any reason.

Selection Criteria

The merit list will be prepared by the selection committee after the Entry Test and Interview. The decision of the selection committee will/shall be final.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Admission notice will be advertised in Local & Foreign Newspapers before the beginning of the academic session. Applications shall be submitted to the Principal, Islamic International Medical College, Al-Mizan Building, 274-Peshawar Road, Rawalpindi, Pakistan. Any application received after due date and time shall not be entertained.
- The admission package includes admission application form, affidavit specimen, hostel admission form and Prospectus.
- Applications should be sent by Registered post/Recorded delivery. Application by hand can also be accepted for which receipt should be obtained.
- All Pakistani National applicants shall fill in the application form along with additional performa with the application and submit to Principal, IIMC.
- The foreign applicants shall fill in two copies of the application form (one original and second photocopy)
- The original copy of the form shall be forwarded to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Government of Pakistan, Islamabad requesting them for grant of political clearance to the candidate and subsequently forwarding their application to Ministry of Education who after completing the formalities shall forward the case to Islamic International Medical College. It would be advisable if foreign applicants send their applications through their own Government Embassy/High Commission in Islamabad, Pakistan.
- The second copy (photocopy) duly filled in by the candidate along with complete educational certificates, photocopies of

passport be sent to Principal Islamic International Medical College directly as an advance copy.

- The foreign applicants will submit an additional certificate to prove that the candidate can read, write, speak and interpret English fluently enough to be able to benefit from the clinical and practical training, which are conducted entirely in English. The certificate should be obtained from the Government or Ambassador or High Commissioner or other competent authority of the country concerned or from the Pakistan Embassy/High Commission in the country.



- An overseas applicant cannot seek admission in any educational institution in Pakistan with a Tourist or Visit Visa and is liable to be deported by the Government of Pakistan as per regulations.
- The College shall not be responsible for foreign/overseas applicant who enters Pakistan with a Tourist/Visit Visa and later on deported by the Government.
- The entry test/interview will be held according to the date, time and place intimated by mail to the applicants after receiving their applications for admission.
- Result/final selection intimation will be dispatched to the successful candidates only.

- The College shall not issue any admission letter to foreign applicant unless clearance from the Government agencies is received.
The candidates who are eligible to apply for admission must submit attested copies of the following documents along with the application forms.
- Matric/Senior Cambridge or equivalent certificate. (One copy)
- Provisional/Character certificate of FSc.(Pre-medical) of the College last attended (Two copies).
- Copies of the detailed marks certificate of FSc (Pre-medical) of the Board of Intermediate and Secondary education(Two copies).
- B.Sc. along with detailed marks sheet. (Two copies).
- No application for admission will be considered unless fully and completely made out on the prescribed form by the candidate in his/her own writing.

Note:

If any of the above certificates/documents are found false or forged, legal action will be taken against the student and he/she will be debarred from admission. Original documents of the selected candidates will be submitted in the College and returned after completion of the course of studies or when student discontinues his/her course of studies after submission of clearance certificates from all departments and library etc. Application forms and photocopies of the documents of candidates, not selected, are not returnable.

The admission fee and other dues will not be refunded to those students whose admission has been cancelled due to his/her fabricated documents or if he/she is rusticated / expelled/removed from the college for any

reasons or he/she discontinues his/her studies. Admission will be provisional. Any candidate whose particulars, certificates or any other documents submitted with the admission form are found incorrect on confirmation from the Board/relevant authority or whose authentication is doubtful will be struck off the College roll, even if the candidate has been admitted.

A student can be expelled from college by the Principal at any time during the course of his/her study, if incorrect or wrong data has been submitted by such candidate/parents/guardian at the time of admission.

No show cause notice will be necessary for any action under this rule, nor would the Government of Pakistan, Principal or University or any other authority be liable for damages for any action under this rule. Candidates who fail to report for interview/admission on the prescribed date shall be considered to have forfeited his /her right of admission (for Pak nationals only).

College Rules Governing Students

General Rules governing the students are mentioned below. All students are advised to read them carefully and abide instructions,

orders, rules/regulations, ethics, moral code and college dress as envisaged in prospectus, college notification, instructions issued by the Principal or on his behalf by the teaching staff, class proctors or class seniors (appointed by the college administration). Violation of these rules tantamount to serious breach of discipline/orders.

1. All students be quiet in college premises. Students are forbidden to sing, whistle, hoot or create noise or indulge in any unseemly behavior or activity in the college premises at any time.
2. Punctuality to class timing and proper discipline in classrooms, practicals, demonstrations and tutorials will be of highest order. Students have to wear white coats during lectures and practicals.
3. No student is allowed to loiter and move aimlessly in and around college premises or while-away his/her time in college canteen/cafeteria or market place. For girls' students, living in hostel, proper bazaar trips will be arranged once a week.

4. No gathering or meeting of students will be allowed in the premises of college and hostels. Any student who wishes to make a representation on any subject has the right to direct access to the Principal at any time during college hours by previous appointment, if not satisfied by his/her interview with the Chief Proctor and Vice Principal.
5. Every part of the college building and hostel premises shall be kept clean e.g., walls, fixtures, models, specimens, charts, etc should not be tempered, defaced, mutilated or damaged in any way or form. Defaulters will be dealt with severely.
6. It is the duty of each student to maintain highest degree of cleanliness of college premises and the hostels including toilets and kitchens.
7. All damages in any form caused by the students due to their negligence or deliberate act shall be repaired at the expense of the student / students responsible for the negligence.
8. No females are allowed to visit or stay in boys hostel and vice versa.
9. In case of voluntary withdrawal the following will apply
 - Admission fee is not refundable
 - Tuition, boarding & lodging fee may be refunded on prorata basis during six weeks following the commencement of the session for which the student has been enrolled. Thereafter, no refund of any kind shall be made.
10. No religious ceremony likely to injure the feelings of other boarders shall be performed in the hostel.
11. Every student shall be in his room by 09:30 p.m. in summer and 08:00 p.m. in winter except those who are on official duty in hospital. These timings are subject to change if so required.
12. Boarders are prohibited from leaving the hostel after 09:30 hrs in summer and 08:00 hrs in winter. Any boarder, who wishes to stay out after this time, shall take prior permission from the warden. Late comers in the hostel will first report to warden of their hostel before going to their rooms.
13. Any student/boarder found guilty of persistent violation of rules shall be suspended or dismissed from college / hostel by the Principal.
14. Defacing walls, orders on notice boards, fixture, furniture & use of electric appliances is strictly prohibited.
15. All cases of sickness must be reported to the authorities. In case of living in hostel warden shall be notified at once for necessary action.
16. College is not responsible for loss of any property, valuables and jewellery etc of the boarders.
17. Smoking is strictly prohibited in college/hostel premises.
18. Use of liquor or any allied substances is strictly prohibited in the college and hostels.
19. In hostels, students must keep their rooms neat, clean and tidy. The bed should be properly arranged and a cover be used. Dirty clothes should be stored separately and removed at once.
20. Parents/guardians are expected to cooperate with the authorities of the college by prevailing upon and motivating their wards not to take part in any antisocial activities.
21. No student should address any conference including press conference, nor write to the press on a political or related subject on matter concerned directly with the administration of the college or any government or educational institution, university in Pakistan or abroad. No posters or banners shall be displayed without the approval of Principal.



22. In case of complaint it will be investigated by senior members of the staff (Head of the Department). If it is of serious nature it will be forwarded to the Academic Council for further investigation and the recommendations will be forwarded to the Principal for further necessary action.
23. In dealing with any breach of discipline, infringement of the rules and regulations mentioned above, the Principal may decide to order appropriate penalty including apology (verbal or written), fine, temporary suspension from the college, removal from the hostel, removal from the college and rustication after due concurrence of College Academic Council and the decision will be conveyed to the Chairman, Board of Governors.
24. For leave or absence, the students must apply in writing the reason for his/her request. Every student is required to attend 75% of lectures. Repeated absence from lectures, classes, seminars, demonstrations and from hospital wards will make a student liable to be expelled from the college.
25. In theory the margin of 25% of absence from lectures, practical classes and demonstrations is intended to cover those absences, which result on account of sickness or special emergencies in families. A written application should be sent to the Principal by the student or their parents in this regard.
26. Students are not allowed to eat and drink from shops or restaurants, which are not allowed or unauthorized on the basis of their hygienic standard and locations.
27. Students are not allowed to indulge in abusive language or fight.
28. The authority may expel a student at any time if it is not satisfied with his/her health, conduct or character.
29. Students have to be present in time at any specified activity of the college.
30. The students must display their name while on the college premises.

Note:

Infringement of these rules is a serious offence.



Migration to IIMC College

Every student has to fulfill the following requirements.

- a. Students of Pakistan origin must be from an institution duly recognized by PM&DC, and affiliated University. For Foreign students the name of the Medical School or College must be included in the World Directory of Medical Schools-WHO.
- b. Students must be 1st class F. Sc (Premedical) or equivalent with not less than 60% marks (unadjusted i.e. minus NCC and Women Guard marks).
- c. Age as per prescribed limit of PM & DC is 17 to 25 years at the time of admission to 1st year MBBS/BDS. It will be calculated accordingly.
- d. Exam MBBS 1st professional (P-I, P-II) with in the permissible chances as per PM & DC rules, (supporting certificate from principal is required). Student will also submit matriculate F. Sc (Premedical) and DM certificate (F.Sc & all passed/failed MBBS Prof Exams from his/her previous University/Medical College).
- e. Student is not expelled from his previous college on disciplinary ground/moral turpitude or exhausted exam chances.

- f. Student intending migration to MBBS classes (2nd year above) must have passed college entry test. Must be registered with PM & DC as medical student with a copy of PM & DC certificate. PM & DC certificate be made part of documents.
- g. No Objection Certificate from the Principal and affiliated chartered University of the college.
- h. All migrating students will remain on provisional admission till they complete all formalities otherwise their name will be struck off the college "Provisional roll" at any time.
- i. Migrating students have to submit complete course curriculum and internal evaluation certificate of each subject from his/her previous institution duly signed by Head of Department/Principal.
- j. The student will be evaluated by the Board of studies of IIMC so as to determine the course covered and is according to IIMC syllabus as far as is possible.
- k. The admission will be subject to approval by the RIU University to which the IIMC is affiliated.
- l. IIMC will not be responsible for foreign / overseas applicants who enter Pakistan with a tourist/visit visa, for medical study, student must have valid study visa from Pakistan Embassy obtained in the country or origin.
- m. For foreign / overseas Pre-medical F.Sc or equivalent exam 'A' level or grade 11 or 12 qualified students. And equivalence certificate from the office of the Inter-Board Committee of Chairman, Islamabad (Pakistan) is to be submitted, indicating equivalence to F. Sc (Pre-medical) 60% marks aggregate/unadjusted of Pakistani Board. The overseas/foreign student has also to submit a NOC from university of origin, duly attested by the Pakistani Embassy in that country.
- n. Parents have sound financial background to support their son/daughter the expenses of medical studies in college.
- o. Principal IIMC may cancel/refuse /remove the student at any time whose particulars / certificates, or any other documents are incomplete, incorrect or with wrong data or from an recognized institution, submitted by such candidates/parents/guardians at the time of admission or during subsequent course of study.
- p. Every migrating student has to give an under taking (on Rs. 10/- Judicial bond countersigned by Public Notary) that he will abide by the Rules, Regulation of IIMC including hostels. Specimen of such under taking would be provided by college authorities.

The migration process does not establish any Judicial / legal right of the applicant of admission in IIMC.

Note

The head scarf is mandatory for female students and it should cover their head, hair, neck and figure properly

Female students should be in full sleeve kameez without slits in sleeves

Any other colour than the prescribed for kameez, shalwar, dopatta, scarf, shirts, trousers, tie, footwear and socks etc is not allowed.

Baggy pants, Jeans, jackets and joggers are not allowed.
